All Research Projects are to be submitted with following documents for consideration by IEC:

1. Name of the applicant & designation.
 2. Name of the Institution / Hospital & field area research.
 3. Approval of project by HOD.
 4. Protocol of proposed research project.
 5. The Ethical issues on the proposed study & how to address those issues.
 6. Written informed consent from all persons participating as volunteer in the said research.
- If Animal experiments are included, a separate clearance from the Animal Ethics committee shall be required.
All documents to be submitted along with research proposal.
The C.V of research workers.

All regulatory clearance, wherever required.

Source of Research funding. Agreement to report Serious Adverse Effect to IEC.

Conflicts of interest if any, to be addressed.

Check all National & International guidelines as complied.

Any financial compensation to participants & volunteers.

Plan for publication of Research outcomes in Journal.

All Research Project approve by IEC to be reviewed periodically.

The Ethics Committee meets frequently to discuss & dispose the various Research projects as well as oversee the hospital patient care activities with special reference to ethical issues.
