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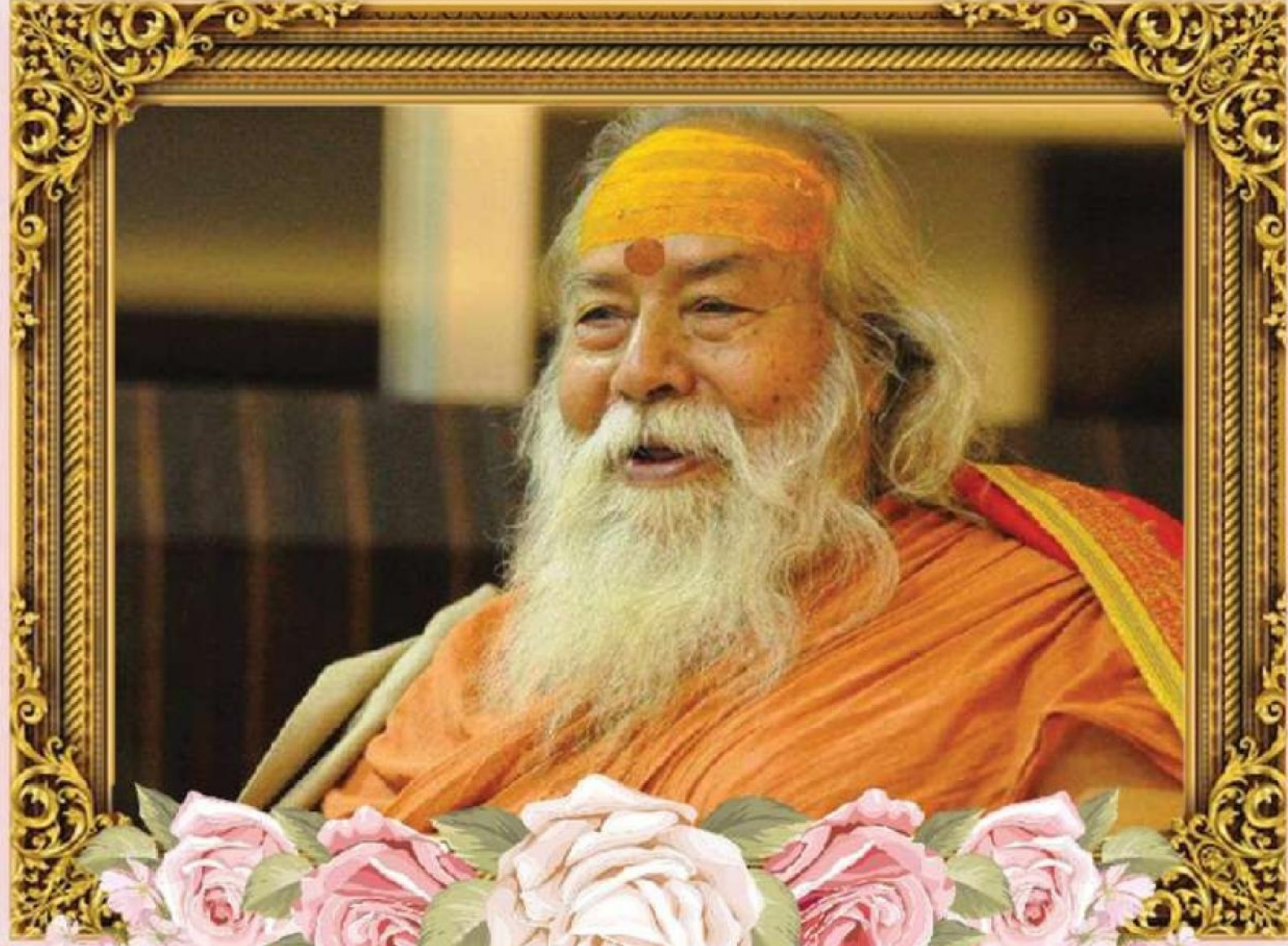

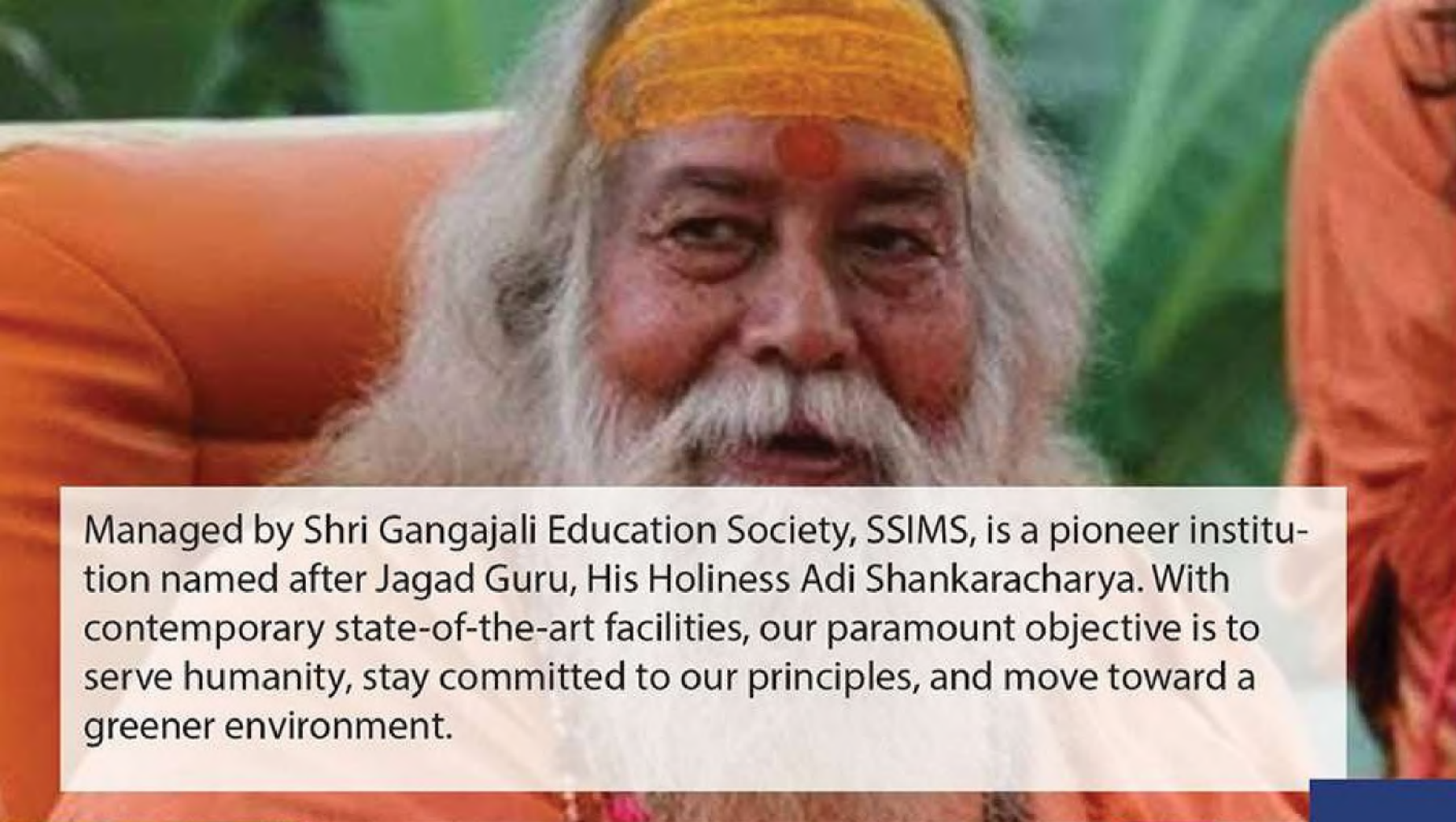

The green campus is spread over many acres of land, accommodating a hospital block, academic block, hostels, holistic and spiritual centres.



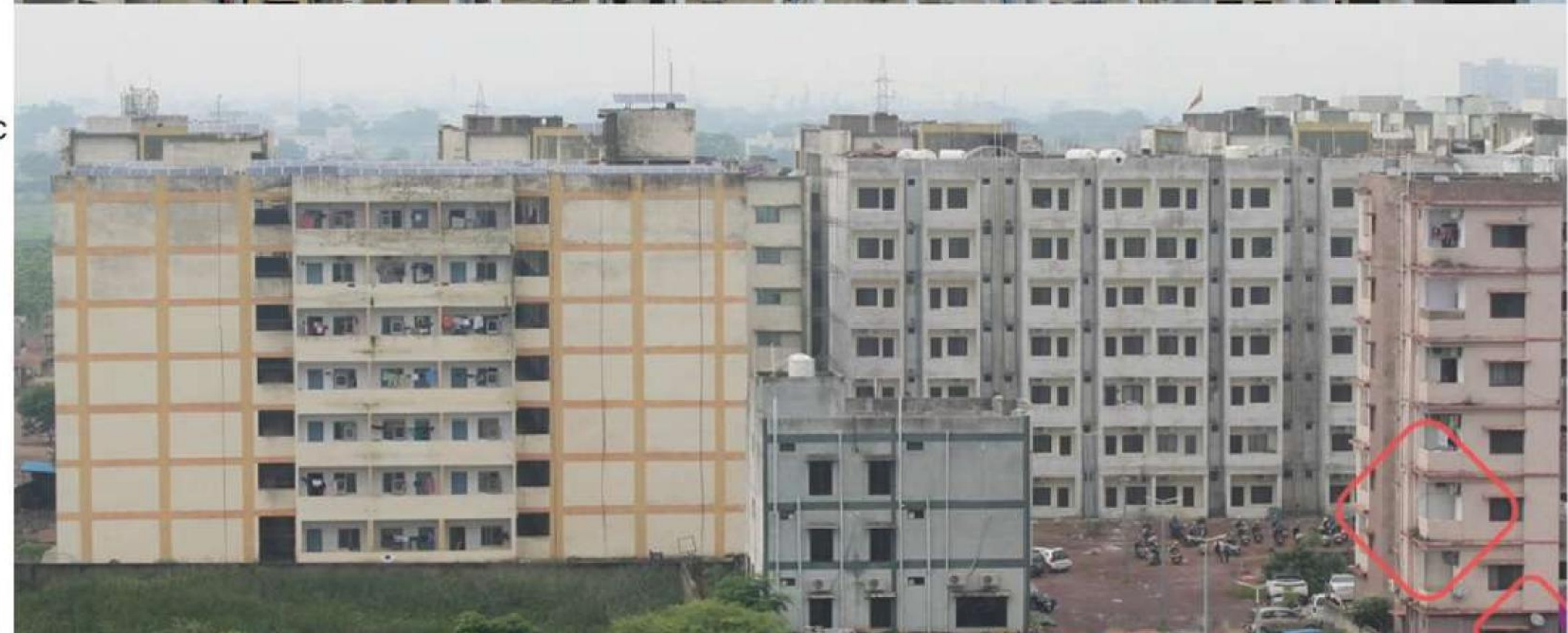
SSIMS provides **MBBS degree** of 5.5 years duration (4.5 Years + 1 Year Internship) and **PG degree** of 3 years duration.



This College is affiliated with Pandit Deendayal Upadhyay Memorial Health Science & Ayush University of Chhattisgarh and is approved by National Medical Commission.



It is located in the heart of Bhilai city, nearest railway station is 3.5 km away, Durg Junction, Railway Colony, and nearest airport is 52.9 km away, Swami Vivekananda International Airport, Raipur. Within 2 kms. there is Bank, ATM facility, Shopping complex, etc.

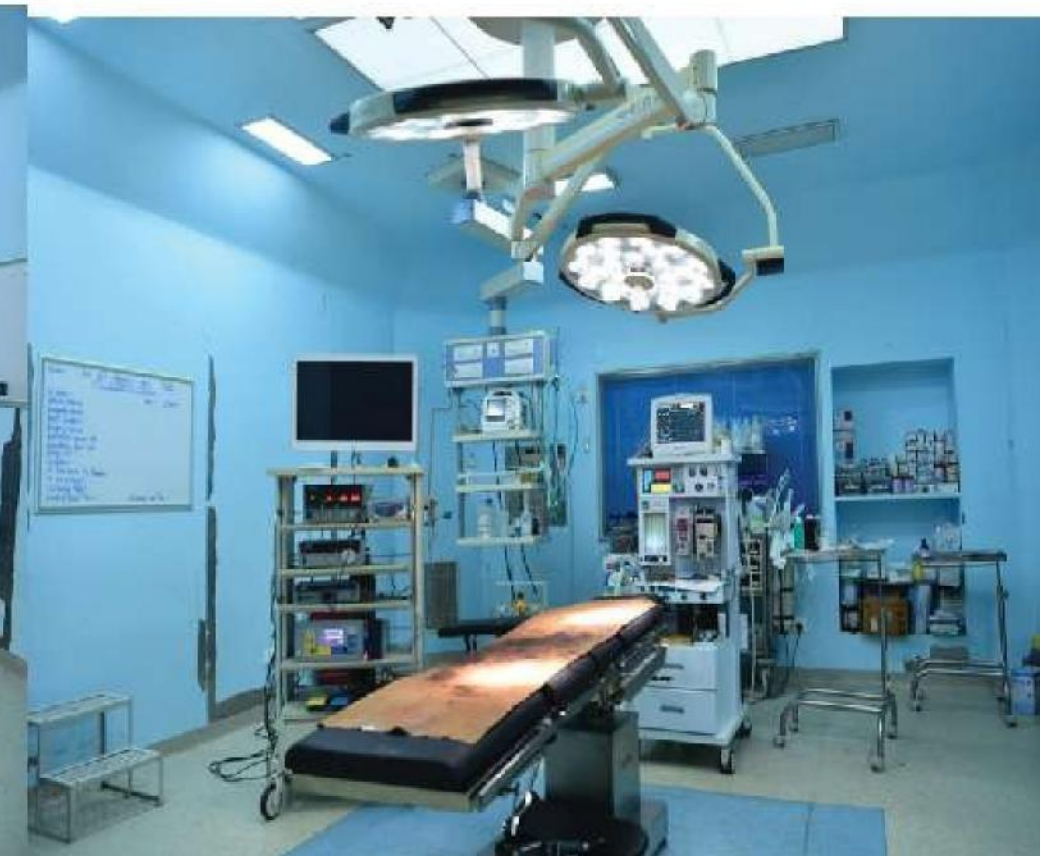

There are 11 Operation Theatres (Surgery, Orthopaedics, Eye, ENT, Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery, Obstetrics and gynaecology, Emergency, Cardiac, Neurosurgery, Urology, Plastic Surgery, Minimal Invasive surgery). Live streaming relay from OT is available in Lecture Theatres. Here, operating surgeons give live narration of surgical procedures.

LIBRARY

SSIMS central library is well equipped with medical books, Periodicals, CDs, DVDs, bound volumes, National and International Journals and E- library.



The library houses approximately 11484 books 72 national journals, and 41 international journals in its collection and has access to many online journals.



E-library facility with both broadband internet and Wi-Fi connectivity.



SSIMS has separate hostel facilities for undergraduate male, female, post-graduate students and intern doctors. It has a separate family quarter for resident doctors and teachers. All of the hostels have Wi-Fi connectivity. The hostels have a common dining area, a TV room and indoor games facilities, with provisions for playing table tennis, carrom and chess. The hostels also have separate reading rooms.





CANTEENS

On the campus of SSIMS there are several spacious and well-lit Canteens and Cafeterias for students, doctors and staff.

A variety of snacks, meals and drinks are available in those canteens and cafeterias.



COMMON ROOMS

In the academic building of SSIMS, there are separate common rooms for male and female students with provision for indoor games such as table tennis, carrom and chess with sufficient seats where students can lounge around and enjoy their leisure period. There are common rooms in hospitals and hostels also.



TRANSPORT FACILITIES

SSIMS has special transport facilities for the students, staff, and faculty members.

Buses and four-wheelers are available for health camps, student field visits for educational purposes and other health-related activities.



SECURITY

SSIMS ensures a safe and secure environment for all members of SSIMS, including students, faculty, staff. The whole campus is under the surveillance of CCTV cameras.

Besides, a sufficient number of security guards are present in different areas of the campus 24 hours a day.

ACADEMIC REPORTS TO GUARDIANS

One of the salient features of SSIMS is that students' academic reports are prepared and freely made available to guardians if they ask. Thus, guardians can monitor the progress of their children.

Apart from that, information about students' academic, administrative or other issues is sent to guardians whenever necessary.



POST-GRADUATE TRAINING PROGRAMS

SSIMS has post-graduate training facilities in all Pre-Clinical, Para Clinical and Clinical departments.

After completing the undergraduate MBBS course, interested doctors need to complete post-graduate training in a specific field of interest for a period of three years to get a post graduate degree in the specialised subject.

Currently, all departments have PG students pursuing their course.



INTERNSHIP PROGRAM



After passing the final professional MBBS examination, students have to enrol for a one-year log book guided rotatory internship program in a respective teaching field which includes compulsory residential posting in a rural health training centre at Beloudi.

The internship program is structured and supervised. It is compulsory to complete an Internship Training Program designed by NMC to get permanent registration for doing independent practice.

At present One batch has successfully completed internship program.



CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

SSIMS proudly believes in the fact that co-curricular activities teach lessons in life, such as teamwork, accountability, self-confidence, and self-discipline.

Pediatric OPD services, Common pediatric ailments treatment (pediatric wards) Care of children, Critical care of neonates and paediatrics (ICU, NICU, PICU), Immunization services, Child Welfare, Child Guidance and Rehabilitation Clinics, OAE screening, Breast-feeding and child nutrition counselling services, Bedside Ultrasound -/ XRAY /ECG

Respiratory Medicine services:

Bronchoscopy, PFT test and DLCO, RICU services For all pulmonary & Covid critical care patients, Aerosol Therapy, Treatment for MDR Tuberculosis on an OPD basis, FNAC from Pleura and Lung, CBNAAT



Skin services:

Electrocautery, Intralesional injections, Skin biopsy & histopathology, PUVA therapy, Excimer laser for vitiligo, psoriasis, Aesthetic procedures, Chemical peel, Laser reduction, Acne scar treatment by MNRF, Laser treatment for tattoo nevus



Eye services:

Computerized eye testing, Glass prescription, Slit lamp Bio microscopy, Ocular Foreign body removal, Chalazion incision & drainage, Fundus/ Retina examination (direct & Indirect ophthalmoscope 20D, 90D, 78D), A - Scan (lens power calculation), Yag Capsulotomy, Laser Peripheral Laser Iridectomy.



Radiology services are:

MRI. 64-slice CT scan. Colour Doppler sonography, Mammography, X-ray.

Orthopaedic services:

Hip and Knee Replacement, Reconstructive surgery for bone tumours, corrective surgery for spastic children and other Paediatric limb deformities, Arthroscopic Joint surgery, Lumbar Discectomy, Decompression and instrumentation for Spinal Tuberculosis, Spondylolisthesis and other Degenerative Spinal Disorders apart from complex peri-articular Limb trauma, mal-unions and non-unions.



Psychiatry services:

Child & Adolescent Psychiatry Clinic, DE-addiction Clinic, Marital & Psychosexual Clinic, Geriatric Psychiatry Clinic, Emergency Psychiatry Services, Consultation liaison services, EEG, ECTs, Biofeedback, Pentothal abreaction, Counselling & Psychotherapy, Psychological.

Surgeries conducted:

All types of Major & Minor Surgical Operations, including Laparoscopic surgery is available. CTVS, Urology, Plastic Surgery, GI Surgical, Neurosurgery, Paediatric Surgery, Surgical Oncology, Any other clinic (Minimal Invasive Surgery), Upper GI Endoscopy, Colonoscopy.



Neurosurgery services:

The primary mission is to deliver quality neurosurgical care to the needy patients population at affordable prices. The department has well equipped Operation Theater functioning all round the year. The department has introduced MIS surgery programme. The department is doing all kind of brain & spine surgery and all major microscopic surgery including skull bone. In future they are planning to introduce endoscopic Neuro surgery for peripheral nerve, fronting & epilepsy surgery.

ENT services:

Otorhinolaryngology OPD, the department has specialty clinics: Oncology clinic, Vertigo clinic, Allergy clinic, Audiology and speech therapy.

Anaesthesiology Services:

It provides, a balanced and safer anesthesia care, even in challenging situations. All clinical departments are anchored to this specialty, and hence-keeping pace with the recent development, they are providing the best practice for various, surgical procedures like General surgery, Orthopedics, Obstetrics and Gynecology, ENT, Plastic Surgery, Urosurgery and Neurosurgery. It also provides services to Cath labs and airway management in other parts of hospital. Also has acute pain services in pain clinics as well as in wards.



Dentistry services:

Full mouth rehabilitation, dental research unit, functional appliances, orthopedic appliances, orthognathic surgery.

Obstetrics & Gynaecology sevices:

Fully equipped with a state-of-art endoscopy unit. It is handling Level 5 endoscopic surgery including, Wertheim's laparoscopic tuboplasty, laparoscopic Sacro colpopexy. A cancer screening program is successfully conducted on an OPD basis where patients are screened by pap smear VIA,VILI ,colposcope ,advanced thermocoagulator. Highly advanced infertility clinics are conducted with all modalities of treatment options available. Menopause clinics have BMD machines and special urogynaecology services to tackle the problems with TOT and TVT. The obstetrics unit has a facility of painless labour and a wireless NST machine which can be monitored by all the consultants on their android phones.



Cardiology department:

Tread Mill Test, Echocardiography (for adult and paediatric), Holter Monitoring (24 & 48 Hours), Electrocardiogram. Ambulatory Blood Pressure Monitoring (24 hrs & 48 hrs), coronary angiography, Permanent pacemaker implantation, Primary angioplasty, FFR & intravascular USG guided complex angioplasties, Balloon valvotomies, AICD, Device closure of ASD, VSD & PDA, Peripheral angioplasty, All Cath lab procedures.



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE STUDENTS

- Every student attending lectures, tutorial & practical classes or hospital duty must put on **proper uniform** provided by institution and long white coat.
- Students are required to wear **simple and decent clothes** in the college and its premises. Wearing T- Shirts without collars/revealing clothes/shirts with slogan printed are not allowed.
- Students should carry their **identity card** while they are inside the College and Hospital.
- Postering and **writing on wall** in the college and hospital premises are prohibited. These are considered as act of indiscipline and those involved are liable to **punishment**.
- Any type of demonstrations, **processions, shouting** in the college and hospital premises is prohibited and students involved in those activities are liable to **punishment**.
- Absences from classes, individuals or in a mass **without permission are punishable** and guardians will be informed of such acts.
- In case the applicant for admission is found to have indulged in **ragging** in the past or if it is noticed later that he has indulged in ragging, admission may be refused or he/she shall be **expelled** from the institution as per judgment of the Hon'ble **Supreme Court of India**.

Students must observe strict discipline in the college. On disciplinary grounds the following penalties may be imposed on a student, depending on the nature of offence:

1. Warning
2. Fines
3. Expulsion from hostel
4. Defer from appearing examinations
5. Any other punishment suggested by academic/disciplinary council



ATTENDANCE

Every student is required to attend punctually, at the hours notified, for all the lectures, demonstrations, practical's, tutorials, tests and clinical classes.

As per NMC regulation on Graduate Medical Education, no student shall be allowed to appear in the professional examination(s) of the concerned subject conducted by university if his/her attendance falls short of 75% in theory and 80% in practical, tutorials and clinical classes. The remaining 20-25% is meant to take care of unforeseen circumstances like family/co-curricular obligations, illness etc. On no account shall a student be given attendance if he/she is NOT physically present in the class.



HOSTEL RULES FOR THE STUDENTS

1. Hostellers are required to take care of their belongings by themselves or items issued to them.
2. The Hostellers can only leave hostel including on holidays with the prior permission of Hostel Warden and approval of Guardian/ Parents.
3. The Hostellers shall not damage any hostel property, In case of violation penal fee will be charged.
4. Parties, Social gatherings in the hostel Complex are not allowed, however, any such event/gatherings can be organized only with the prior permission from the competent authority.
5. Possession of any firearms, lethal weapons, and poisonous things in the hostel is strictly prohibited. Any one if found guilty then immediate expulsion from the Hostel and matter will be reported to central authorities as per law.
6. No male guardian/relative/students shall be permitted to enter the Girls' Hostel premises in any circumstances, action will be taken including removal from the Hostel in case of violation of rule. There is a fully furnished guest house available near the hostel.
7. Electrical appliances oven, kettle, stove, induction is strictly prohibited.
8. Hostel closing time will be 9.00pm how ever in case of emergency the prior approval in advance to be taken from competent authority.
9. Any parcel or courier service in the hostel premises will be accepted only till 9.00pm.

ADMISSION INFORMATION & RECOGNITION

Affiliated to : Pandit Deendayal Upadhyay Memorial Health Science & Ayush University of Chhattisgarh

Approved by : National Medical Commission (NMC)

Counselling Conducted Authority : Directorate of Medical Education (DME), Raipur

Eligibility Criteria for Admission in MBBS Course

Candidates must complete their 10+2 examination by securing a minimum 50% of marks from any recognized board.

Candidates must have studied Chemistry, Physics, and Botany/Zoology as compulsory subjects in class 12th.

Reserved category students are provided 10% relaxation (40% in class 12th).

There is no upper age limit to be eligible for this exam. However, candidates must be at least 17 years old to be applicable to apply for the NEET Exam.

In order to get admission to the MBBS course, candidates must appear for the NEET entrance exam. The NEET entrance exam is conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA).

NEET is the only National Level Entrance Exam accepted by the Medical Colleges in India to offer admission to Medical Courses.
